



WHO ARE WE?

The anesthesia clinician (anesthesiologist, certified nurse anesthetist and/or anesthesiologist assistant) for your upcoming surgery/procedure will be provided by Envision Physician Services. We work with your provider in your care.

WHAT IS ANESTHESIA?

Anesthesia involves managing your comfort throughout your surgery/procedure by helping control sleep and pain. The type you receive (general, regional or monitored anesthesia care) will be determined by your anesthesia clinician.

NO INSURANCE COVERAGE

Please contact our Preservice Representatives before your procedure to obtain an estimate and discount.

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM ANESTHESIA

Before Your Procedure – Your anesthesia clinician will ask you to stop eating, drinking and smoking before your surgery. Be sure to follow these instructions to avoid rescheduling.


After Your Procedure – You will be instructed not to consume alcohol or drive immediately after surgery but to drink plenty of fluids and rest. You will also be contacted to complete a survey about your experience.

Side Effects – Side effects may include difficulty concentrating, feeling groggy or nauseous. Your anesthesia clinician will advise on the administration of pain medication after your surgery, some of which have their own side effects.

More details will be provided before and after your operation.

BILLING
